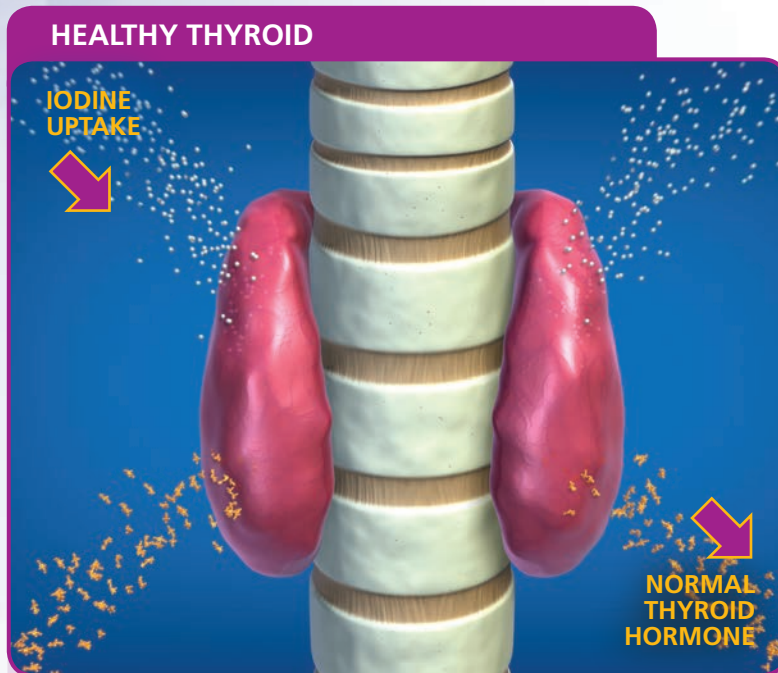
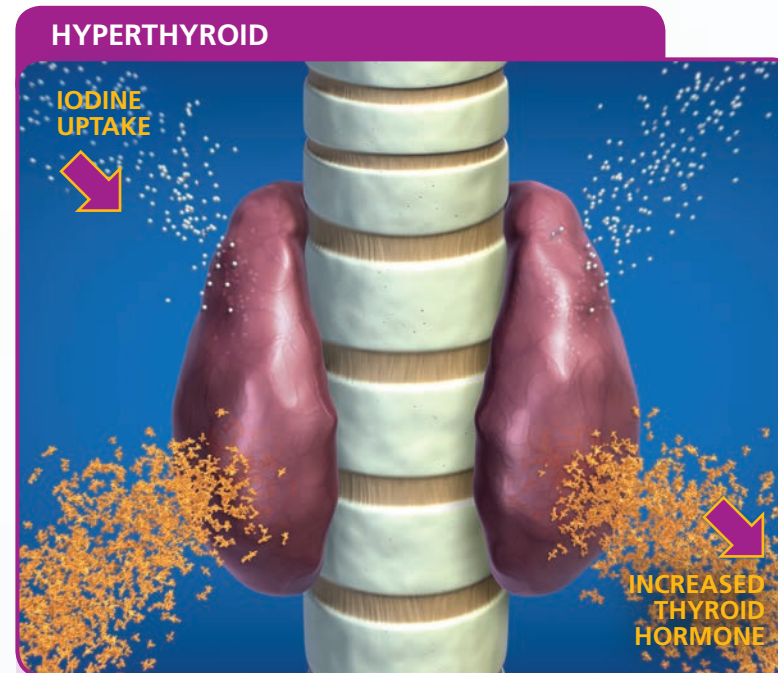


What is feline hyperthyroidism?

- Gastrointestinal (bowel) function

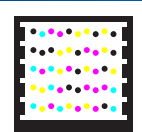


The thyroid gland enlarges and produces excessive amounts of thyroid hormone.

- Increased thirst
- Increased appetite
- Poor skin and coat condition
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Hyperactivity

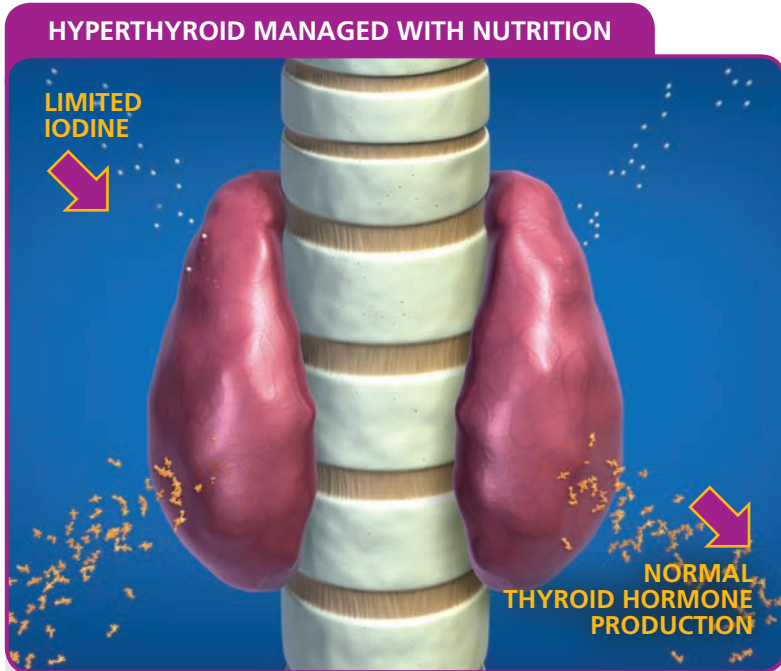
